

Dr. George T. Solomon is currently Professor of Management and co-founder and Director for the Center for Entrepreneurial Excellence (CFEE) at the George Washington University School of Business. Since 2010, he has served as Editor-in-Chief of the *Journal of Small Business Management*. Dr. Solomon is the past president of the United States Association for Small Business and Entrepreneurship (USASBE) and the International Council for Small Business (ICSB) and since 1996 has served as chair for the Wilford L. White Fellows.

From 1976 until 2004, Dr. Solomon held various managerial positions at the SBA including director of the Office of Special Initiatives and Deputy Associate Administrator for Business Initiatives Education and Training. In 1983, he was only one of five federal employees worldwide to receive the Arthur S. Flemming award for excellence in government management making him only the second person to receive this award in the history of the U.S. Small Business Administration.

Dr. Solomon has published and edited over 130 articles, books of readings, book chapters, reference materials and proceedings articles in both the areas of entrepreneurship/small business management and organizational behavior & dynamics. He is the founder and principal investigator of the Global Survey of Entrepreneurship Education which is an expansion of the US Survey of Entrepreneurial Education which he developed in 1979.
