

K. Mark Weaver Short Bio

In 2015, Dr. Weaver retired from the Mitchell College of Business at the University of South Alabama as the Ben May Chair of Entrepreneurship and Executive Director of the Melton Center for Innovation and Entrepreneurship. He formerly served as the Thomas H. Daigre Endowed Chair at Louisiana State University (2006-2011) where he founded the Stephenson Entrepreneurship Institute. Earlier, Dr. Weaver served as the Rohrer Chair of Entrepreneurial Studies at Rowan University (2002-2006) and as a Professor of Management at the University of Alabama (1976-2001).

In January 2015, he was recognized with the Max Wortman Jr. Lifetime Achievement in Entrepreneurship Award, presented by United States Association of Small Business and Entrepreneurship (USASBE). In 2014, he received the Mobile, Alabama Chamber of Commerce Innovator of the Year Award for the University of South Alabama's Coastal Innovation Hub.

Dr. Weaver received his BS degree in Industrial Management and a PhD in Management from Louisiana State University. Dr. Weaver has consulted with universities and organizations in the United States, Europe, Africa, Asia, Australia, and Mexico.
